MEMORANDUM OF THE ASSOCIATION

- 1. Name of the Association** : **Srinivasa Educational Society**
- 2. Address** : **D.No.17/178, Kapu Street
Jammalamadugu - 516434
Kadapa District, AP State**

3. Aims and Objectives

- a) The main aim of the society is to uplift the financial position of the people who are in poverty, especially lower and middle class families of the society without caste, creed, colour and religion.
- b) To develop socio-economical, cultural, educational, health, agricultural and moral values of the unprivileged classes especially Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribes, Backward Classes and other communities in the area.
- c) To render free and selfless social service for the unprivileged classes irrespective of caste, creed and religion.
- d) To diffuse useful knowledge and promote the sense of unity, co-operation, education, scientific knowledge and others among the rural population.
- e) To establish and run Residential Schools, Hostels, Libraries, Orphanages, Day care centres, destitute homes Technical Centres, Vocational Training centres and other useful institutes to improve the Technical education in the rural areas for the welfare of the disadvantaged groups.
- f) To maintain and run libraries, youth clubs, village committees etc.,
- g) To establish and run Educational Institutions like Academic, Pre-primary, primary, secondary, Higher Secondary Schools, Junior Colleges, Degree Colleges, Post graduate centres to improve the Academic education both Telugu and English Medium.
- h) To implement women and child welfare programmes, Mother and child care programmes, Health care centres etc., to take care of the aged people, Orphanage homes, physically handicapped centres, child labour schools etc.,
- i) To undertake subsidy occupations such as Dairy, Poultry, Sheep rearing and Piggery etc., as may be suitable for local conditions with a view to increase the family income and to create employment opportunities for its members.

- j) To start Asram Schools, Schedule Caste, Tribes Schools and Hostels etc., for the welfare of poor children in the rural areas.
- k) To form Thrift and credit unions and to receive loans from Rastriya Mahila Kosh (RMK) New Delhi and other Agencies for the benefit of the rural poor people.
- l) To encourage and take up the developmental projects like Agricultural, Horticulture, Sericulture, Wasteland Development projects, Environmental and Ecological balances, Tree plantation and suitable welfare activities for the rural areas like Income Generating Schemes, Housing Schemes, Formation of Roads, Drinking water facilities, Sanitation, Medical and Health programmes, Ari Pollution, Construction of Checkdams to uplift the living conditions of the rural and downtrodden groups in the area.
- m) To raise and receive subscriptions, donations from members and local people, to receive funds or grants in the shape of Cash and kind from Donor Agencies both from our Country and Abroad and also to utilize the subsidies, margin money and other benefits from Government and Non-Governmental agencies to run the programmes for the benefit of the rural and urban population.
- n) To provide legal support to the poor and deprived sections of the community in order to help them to win their legal rights.
- o) To provide Medical assistance to schedule Caste, Schedule Tribes by arranging periodical free Medical check-ups by qualified doctors and distribute medicines free of cost with the assistance of doctors and nurses and other funding sources.
- p) To promote wasteland development activities, Eco-development projects, Soil conservation and Social forestry schemes, Nurseries, Watershed arrangements, Checkdams, De-silting of tanks, open wells, Agri. Bore wells for the benefit of the ecology and all other environmental activities.
- q) To do all such other useful things, deeds, acts which are essential or conducive to the attainment of the objecting the society.

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE ASSOCIATION



1. Name of the Association : Srinivasa Educational Society
2. Address : D.No.17/178, Kapu Street
Jammalamadugu - 516434
Kadapa District, AP State
3. Jurisdiction : The Area of operation shall be
entire "~~ANDHRA PRADESH STATE~~"

4. Membership

a) Any person who is a resident of Andhra Pradesh State, male or female, who has attained 18 years and above age is eligible and who is desirous to become a member of the society, shall abide by the rules and regulations of the society, on payment of Rs.50/- as admission fee and Rs.2/- as subscription per month i.e. Rs.24/- per annum.

b) Termination of Membership

By the death or Resignation, becoming of unsound mind, by not receiving the membership by paying the fee within three months from the end of each official year. However, Executive Committee may condone any member and readmit him/her to membership provided such members pay all the arrears due to the society.


c) By not attending three meetings consecutively of the society, they loose their respective offices. But the Executive Committee of the society may restore the membership upon a requisition made in writing addressed to it but such facilities will be available for three occasions only.

5. Meetings:

a) General Body:

The society shall convey a general body meeting once in a year preferably in the month of April. All the matters connected with the affairs of the society shall be discussed and decided in the meeting. The election of the office bearers shall also be conducted in the meeting. The quorum of this meeting shall be $\frac{1}{2}$ of the members on roll.

b) Executive Committee

The Executive committee meeting shall be convened once in every two months or six times in a year giving at least 2 days advance notice to members of Executive Committee. For any emergency purpose, 24 hours prior written notice shall be given for convening the Executive Committee meeting. The Executive Committee meeting shall be convened by the President.



6. **Executive Committee (or) Governing Body**

The Executive Committee shall consist of president, vice-president, secretary, joint secretary, treasurer and 4 members in total -9. The president committee will hold office for a period of two years.

7. **Powers of the Executive Committee**

a) **President:**

the President shall preside over all the meetings and review. He shall be the Chief Executive of the Society. He shall organize the activities of the society in proper manner. He shall conduct both General Body/ Executive Body meetings regularly. He shall have control and custody of the property of the society. He shall raise the loans on interest from Government or private bodies or Donor Agencies for organizing the welfare of the society.

b) **Vice President:**

Vice President shall act as President in the absence of the President of the Society.

c) **Secretary**

To convene meetings by circulating meeting agendas to members in advance. To supervise the activities of the society. He shall be responsible for the proper conduct of the office and carry on such duties as are entrusted to him by the president, He shall maintain all the books of accounts.

d) **Joint Secretary**

The joint secretary shall assist the secretary in carrying out the duties of the secretary in his absence.

e) **Treasurer**

He shall be custodian of the cash and accounts and he shall be responsible for placing the accounts before the General Body meeting. He shall collect membership fee, subscriptions, Donations from the members and public and give proper receipt to them. He shall act as per the directions of the President.

f) **Members:**

The remaining members shall assist the President in smooth running of the activities of the society.

7. **Audit of Accounts:**

The accounts for the year commencing from April every year and place the audited accounts in the annual meetings, audited by a Chartered Accountant and appointed by the General Body of the Society.



8. Legal Matters

The Society may sue or be sued in the name of the President only. Legal Advisor(s) shall be appointed by the Executive Committee from time to time and their remuneration fixed, subject to Jurisdiction of Jammalamadugu Court.

9. Quorum

The Quorum for General Body meeting shall be 3/5th of members on roll. Within half an hour after the schedule time, if there is no quorum the meeting shall stand adjourned.

10. Funds:

The funds of the Society shall be utilized for welfare activities of the Society. Funds shall be raised by way of Donations from public, and both state and central government, A.P.S.Social Welfare Advisory Board, NABARD and Abroad agencies. The joint account should be opened in any Nationalized Bank in the name of President and Secretary preferably, who are empowered to do bank transactions i.e. deposits and withdrawal on behalf of the Society.

11. Income Tax Exemption Act

- a) the Society will invest the funds in accordance with the provisions of the Sections 13(1) & (d) read with section 11(5) of the Income Tax Act, 1961.
- b) The Society formed under the above name shall be irrevocable.
- c) The accounts of the Society will be maintained regularly and audited by the qualified auditor (Chartered Accountant) for every financial year.
- d) The funds/income of the Society shall solely be utilized towards the objects for which it received and as specified in the Memorandum and Bye-law of the Society and will not be paid to any Trustee/member of the Society.
- e) The Society can be dissolved if any reason with 3/5th majority at the time fixed and dispose the properties to any other Society Registered with Commissioner of Income Tax U/s 12 A & 80 G of I.T. Act and working on the similar objectives after clearing all debts but not to the members as per Sec.13 and 14 of the Act.
- f) The Society will render services to General, Public and such services are open to all irrespective of Caste, religion and Sex etc.,
- g) The Society will not make any Amendments/Deed without the written permission of the Commissioner of Income Tax.
- h) The Society shall not carry out any activities outside India.

12. Suits

The Society may sue or to be sued in the name of the President as determined by the rules and regulations of the Registered Society as per the Provisions laid down in Section (6) of the Society Act, XXI of 1860.



13 Enforcement of Judgment

The enforcement of Judgment against the property of the Society shall be in accordance with the provisions of section (8) of the Societies Act, XXI of 1860.

14 Dissolution

In the event of the dissolution of the Society, it will be dissolved as per the provisions of Section (13) and (14) of the Societies Registration Act, XXI of 1860.

15 Amendments

If the Society wishes to alter, amend and to make additions and deletions to the memorandum and Rules and Regulations of the Society, the provisions of section (12) of the Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860 will be followed.
